This campaign is about **more than a building** - this is about protecting a place where people discover, create, perform, learn, laugh and belong. **Lead with people and stories.** Be warm, positive, proud, inclusive and hopeful. Invite people to join something extraordinary! **Community ownership means lasting security** - it will help us all care for the building and unlock investment that is currently difficult to access.

Plan your fundraiser

1. **Tell Claire before you publicise it – claire@bridport-arts.com** Share the idea, date, venue and any support or materials you need – we have lots of marketing assets, design files etc, and can promote your event in our social media posts and *Come Together* newsletter.
2. **Use “in aid of Bridport Arts Centre’s *Come Together* campaign”.** Unless BAC has expressly asked and directed you, you are organising independently and remain responsible for the activity.
3. **Agree how funds will reach BAC.** Use the official donation page where possible; otherwise record income and costs, safeguard cash and transfer proceeds promptly.
4. **Be clear** about prices, deducted costs and what the proceeds support. Never pressure anyone to give. We can help you with anything you might be unsure about.
5. **Check permissions and risks.** Speak to Claire before any raffle/lottery, public collection, alcohol sale, higher-risk challenge or activity involving children. Permissions, licences, insurance, safeguarding, accessibility, food hygiene and allergen controls may apply.

Where the money will go

Donations are restricted to buying the freehold, priority repairs and restoration, and associated costs. If the full target is not reached or the original purchase cannot proceed, funds will remain restricted to property, capital and directly related relocation work needed to secure BAC’s future. Any surplus will serve the same restricted purposes. Trustees will act in the charity’s best interests and keep supporters informed of significant changes.
