

Donations to the *Come Together* campaign will be restricted for use in the purchase of the freehold itself, priority repair and restoration works and associated costs.

If we do not raise the full target, or if circumstances change so that the original project cannot proceed, Bridport Arts Centre will retain the donations received and hold them as restricted funds. These funds will be used only for property, capital and directly related relocation work needed to secure the charity's future and enable Bridport Arts Centre to continue operating and delivering its charitable activities in Bridport.

This could include repairing, adapting or improving our present building; acquiring, leasing, adapting or fitting out alternative premises; purchasing essential equipment; and meeting professional, legal and relocation costs directly connected with securing a suitable home for the charity. If our present building is sold to a third party and our lease is not renewed, the funds may therefore be used to help Bridport Arts Centre move to and establish itself in a new home. The Board of Trustees of Bridport Arts Centre reserves the right to vary the terms of funding receivable from any particular donor.

If the appeal raises more than is required for the original project, any surplus will be held and used for the same restricted purposes. Decisions about the use of the fund will be made by Bridport Arts Centre's trustees in the charity's best interests and in keeping with the intentions of the appeal. We will keep our supporters informed about any significant change to the project.
